TK/K Enrollment Information: 2026-27 SCHOOL YEAR

It is time to enroll your child for TK and Kinder for the 26/27 school year. Spread the word.

The application for TK and Kindergarten enrollment for the 2026-27 school year opened on November 1. Applications will continue to be accepted throughout the year on a first-come, first-served basis, as space allows at your resident school.

Kindergarten: Children who turn five years of age on or before September 1, 2026 are eligible to enroll in Kindergarten only.

Transitional Kindergarten: Children who turn four years of age on or before September 1, 2026 are eligible to enroll in the TK program only.

We ask all of our parents/guardians to register w/ Be A Mentor for level #1 - general volunteer. This clearance will allow you to be on campus and/or in the classroom with the children. All volunteers must be finger printed. Here is the link to sign up. Be A Mentor Click on the New Volunteers Apply Now on the bottom right side of the page.

Clarification regarding volunteer drivers. As of June 2025, all volunteers who wish to drive on a field trip will need to complete the DMV report through their Be A Mentor account. There is a \$2.00 fee for this process. Be sure to upload your Driver's License information as well.


Make sure you have at least 2-3 students in a photo, preferably the same grade level.
















Battle of the Books:



Breakfast and lunch will continue to be offered free of charge for all students for the 25/26 school year, funded through the California Universal Meals Program.

Can my child purchase a second meal?

Yes, but they need to have funds on their prepayment account, which can be done on the Titan Family Portal. Cash will not be accepted in the breakfast or lunch line. Cash or checks can be given to the Child Nutrition Manager outside of the breakfast or lunch meal service time. A second breakfast is \$4.00 and a second lunch is \$5.75 at Elementary Schools and \$6.00 at Middle and High Schools. School staff can purchase a breakfast for \$4.50 and lunch for \$6.00.
