Principal's Corner

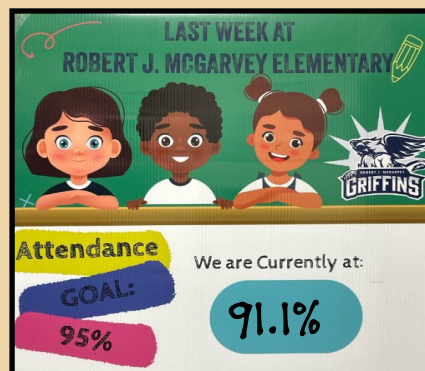
It's here ... the last week of the school year! We're looking forward to all the celebrations this week!

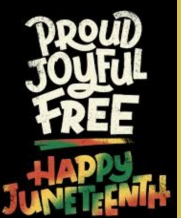

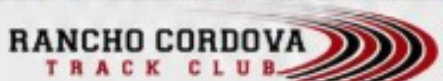

ParentVUE & StudentVUE

Beginning with the 2026–27 school year, Edupoint, the developer of our Synergy student information system, will discontinue support for the current ParentVUE and StudentVUE mobile apps available in the Apple App Store and Google Play Store. Families who use the mobile apps will need to download the new ParentVUE and StudentVUE apps to continue accessing student information.

The new apps are available now, and families are encouraged to install them before the transition. Users who still have the current apps installed and attempt to access them after August 3, 2026, will be prompted to download the new versions.

WEEKLY FOOD DISTRIBUTION IN ELK GROVE

A weekly food distribution in Elk Grove supports families and individuals facing food insecurity. Through a collaborative partnership between Cosumnes CSD, the City of Elk Grove, Al-Misbaah, and Sacramento Food Bank & Family Services, families in need can receive fresh produce, non-perishable food, diapers, and essential household items every Wednesday, year-round, at 10:15 a.m. at Bartholomew Sports Park (10150 Franklin High Road).
