Students are able to retake a new version of their quiz for up to full credit.

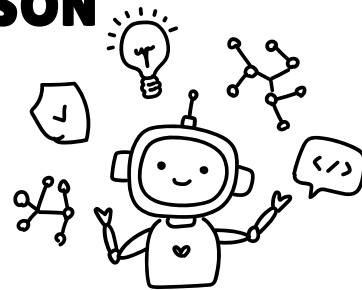
Unit tests can be corrected and turned in for half of the credit missed.
