RE: **Kathy Hausman Memorial Scholarship**

The Kathy Hausman Memorial Scholarship honors the life and legacy of Kathy Hausman, a woman whose kindness, compassion, and commitment to others inspired those around her. This scholarship aims to support students who exemplify the same spirit through their character, service, and dedication to making a positive impact on their community.

Eligibility Criteria:

Applicants should demonstrate:

- **Compassion and Empathy:** A genuine concern for the well-being of others and a record of kindness in interactions with peers, family, or community members.
- **Integrity and Responsibility:** A strong moral compass, showing honesty, reliability, and a dedication to upholding high ethical standards.
- **Perseverance and Self-Control:** A commitment to facing challenges with determination and a thoughtful approach to personal growth.
- **Service and Generosity:** Active involvement in helping others, whether through community service, volunteer work, or leadership roles that benefit their school or local organizations.

Selection Process:

Scholarship recipients will be selected based on a combination of their academic achievements, personal statements, and recommendations highlighting these qualities. The goal is to recognize students who carry forward Kathy's legacy by exemplifying qualities that uplift and strengthen their communities.

Scholarship Details: Four \$500 scholarships will be awarded—at least one to a graduating senior from each of the following Tehama County High School Districts: Corning, Los Molinos, and Red Bluff. The scholarship is intended for students continuing their education after high school.

Recipients will receive \$500, disbursed in two installments of \$250 per semester, upon submission of written proof of college registration. The scholarship funds can be used for books, tuition, supplies, or other educational expenses.

Application Deadline: Completed applications must be submitted by **Monday, April 6, 2026, at 4:00 PM (no exceptions).**

Save the Date: Tentative scholarship interviews will take place on the afternoon of **Wednesday,**

April 22, 2026.
