SCHOLARSHIP	No handwritten forms will be accepted. Applications must be submitted online at https://oafb.org/foundation/scholarships/ashtabula-county-scholarship/ . Applications must be completed entirely by the applicant. The use of artificial intelligence (AI) tools to generate responses or content is not permitted and may result in disqualification.
AWARD	Amount determined by the number of qualifying applications. Recipients will be announced in the spring and acknowledged at the County Farm Bureau Annual Meeting in September. Recipients or a representative must attend the Annual Meeting to receive the award. Scholarship funds will be distributed after the recipient completes one quarter/semester and submits grades to the Farm Bureau office. Unclaimed funds after one year will be forfeited. Applicant and/or parent/guardian must have an active Ashtabula County Farm Bureau membership at the time of application and at payout. Ashtabula County Farm Bureau reserves the right to withhold funds if requirements are not met. Funds not claimed within one (1) year will be forfeited.
ELIGIBILITY	Applicants must meet the following criteria: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Must be a resident of Ashtabula County.• The applicant must be either a current Ashtabula County Farm Bureau member or a dependent of a parent/guardian who is a current Ashtabula member at the time of application and at the time of scholarship payout.• Enrolled full-time in a two- or four-year college, university, or technical school pursuing an undergraduate degree.• Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.• Major in agriculture or a support field is preferred but not required.• May receive the scholarship a maximum of two (2) times.
SELECTION	Applications are reviewed anonymously by an advisory committee appointed by the County Farm Bureau Board of Trustees. Evaluation is based on academics, community involvement, and essays, with emphasis on agricultural involvement and Farm Bureau participation. Committee decisions are final.
