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TEA PRS ATTENDANCE WAIVER

- CEHI (Compulsory Education Home Instruction) is offered off campus for eligible students during their prenatal, postpartum, and extended postpartum recovery periods of pregnancy
 - The program provides academic services to the student at home or hospital bedside when a valid medical necessity for confinement prevents the student from attending classes on a district campus.
 - Provides for in-home and off-campus instruction with a 4:1 ration
 - Currently virtual
- The waiver provides flexibility that will increase educational opportunities for these at-risk students and help offset the District's cost*, as well as ensure more students remain on track for graduation and not become a dropout

*Weighted funding for 4/6hrs per week at 2.41 for five full school days

SCHOOL-AGE PARENTING PROGRAM

- A dropout prevention program under Family Support Services that is providing case management and support to our school-age pregnant and parenting students until graduation and after
- We currently have 59 students (Prg and/or Prt)
- Strengthening Families and Strengthening Relationships partnership with Texas State University
