2.1 Superintendent’s Update – Craig Guensler

- Superintendent Guensler explained the differences of a regular and special board meeting since the question has come up. For a regular meeting the agenda must be posted 72 hours prior to the meeting, and the special board meeting is 24 hours before. They must be posted in a public location and on the district website. The agendas must have the time, location and a brief description of the items. When the District distributes the agenda to the board members, it must be made available to the public at the same time.

**3. COMMUNICATION FROM THE PUBLIC –
(on items not on the agenda)**

The Public may address the Board on any matter pertaining to the school district that is not on the agenda. Unless otherwise determined by the Board, **each person is limited to five (5) minutes**. If a large number wish to speak on a specific item, the Board may limit total input to twenty-five (25) minutes on any item. The Board is not allowed to take action on any item, which is not on the agenda except as authorized by Government Code Section 54954.2.

- A community member asked how much it costs the district to respond to the questions continually asked through social media to which Superintendent Guensler replied that time is a big part of it. The actual cost would be difficult to come up with. If you take the hourly wages of all of the people it takes to research and answer these questions could be significant. Legal fees can be somewhat significant and all of that money comes out of the general fund.
