The California College Promise Program provides ***FREE TUITION*** to high school seniors for the first two years of community college for most programs. There is no income requirement, but you must complete your financial aid application during your senior year.

- In the Fall of your Senior Year:
 - 1) Begin your financial aid application (FAFSA/CADAA) that opens **October 2025**; to get your first two years of college tuition for free (for most programs, you must be a full-time student with at least 12 units).
- In the Spring of your senior year.
 - 1) Applications open on February 1st. Launch through www.CaliforniaColleges.edu
 - 2) Financial Aid application priority deadline **March 2026**
 - 3) Create student portal and email accounts.
 - 4) Complete College Orientation.
 - 5) Check Math & English Placement.
 - 6) Enroll in classes and pay your fees.
