Dear Inter-District Families,

Welcome to Pleasant Grove School. The administration, staff, and Board of Trustees value inter-district students and the contribution they make to our school. The vast majority of our inter-district students make only positive contributions to both the school and the educational program. Having said that, however, on occasion an inter-district student will have academic, behavior, or attendance issues.

As outlined in the Terms and Conditions of Interdistrict Transfer, inter-district students are required to maintain good attendance, acceptable behavior, and passing grades, and participate fully in distance learning as directed by the school. This would include fulfilling requirements in independent study agreements. This criteria will be reviewed by the administration at the end of each trimester or as needed. Students failing to meet the inter-district conditions will be placed on probation. A student who engages in misconduct for which he/she could be recommended for suspension or expulsion as described in the Education Code (except EC 48900(K)) will have his/her transfer immediately revoked and shall be transferred to his or her district or residence immediately.
