Counseling Corner:

- Athletic Academic Eligibility: The first quarter grading period ends October 10, 2025. This
 grading period affects both fall and winter athletes. All student-athletes/team members must
 earn a GPA of 2.0+ for the grading period. Students must have no more than 2 NC/NM on
 their grade report.
- Students will be granted two weeks from the end of the grading period to pass Essentials
 or to make up tests from the grading period to meet athletic eligibility requirements.
 - Students will become ineligible for participation on their team beginning on Friday,
 October 24, 2025, if they have 3+ NC/NM or a GPA below 2.0 for the grading period.
 - Students must inform their teachers that a grade change for athletic purposes is needed.
