NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Paradise Unified School District of Butte County, California, acting by and through its Governing Board, hereinafter referred to as the District, will receive up to, but not later than **2:00 p.m. on Monday, September 28, 2026**, at Paradise High School, 5911 Maxwell Drive, Paradise, CA 95969, or by electronic mail as provided below, sealed bids for the award of contracts for the following:

The Request for Bids consists of twelve (12) commodity-category bid packages. Vendors may submit bids on any one or more bid packages. Bids may be submitted in a sealed package plainly marked with the RFB number and the bid package title(s), or electronically by email to jtaft@pusdk12.org with the RFB number and bid package title(s) in the subject line. Emailed bids must be received by the date and time stated above and will be kept secure and unopened until the public bid opening. The District is not responsible for late, misdirected, or undeliverable transmissions.

Bids will be opened publicly at **2:00 p.m. on Monday, September 28, 2026**, at Paradise High School, 5911 Maxwell Drive, Paradise, CA 95969. Written questions regarding this RFB must be submitted no later than 4:00 p.m. on Monday, September 14, 2026.

This procurement is funded in whole or in part with federal Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds through the California Department of Housing and Community Development and the Town of Paradise Workforce Development RISE Initiative. The successful bidder(s) must comply with all applicable federal procurement requirements, including 2 CFR Part 200, and applicable federal contract provisions. Small businesses, minority-owned businesses, women's business enterprises, and Section 3 businesses are encouraged to submit bids.

The District reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality or irregularity in any bid received, and to award bid packages individually or in any combination determined to be in the best interest of the District. No bidder may withdraw its bid for a period of ninety (90) calendar days after the date set for the receipt of bids. The District may withdraw the RFB at its sole discretion at any time.
