ELA	Complete the ELA assignment provided by your teacher. Notes from Teacher:	Read a book, magazine, article, or other grade-level-appropriate material for 20 minutes. Write a 3-4 sentence summary of what you read and a reaction to it. Be sure to include the title of the book, magazine, article, or other grade-level-appropriate material.	
Math	Complete the Math assignment provided by your teacher. Notes from Teacher:	Complete one of these math activities: • Multi-Digit Addition/Subtraction: Create two multi-digit math equations—one addition and one subtraction—using 2-digit or 3-digit numbers. Solve each equation and show your work by drawing a picture or writing out your steps. • Multiplication Arrays: Gather some small objects (like buttons or coins) and arrange them into rows and columns to create a multiplication array. Count the objects in each row and column, then write the multiplication equation (for example, $3 \times 4 = 12$) to show your work. Create at least 2 different multiplication arrays and equations.	
Science	Complete the Science assignment provided by your teacher. Notes from Teacher:	Pick one gadget from home (like a stapler, can opener, cellphone, or remote). Look at your gadget and write 2-3 sentences answering: • What is the gadget and why did you choose it? • What does it do, and how does it work? • Try using it and write one question you have about it. If needed, an adult can help you write sentences.
