



- Title I, Part A financial assistance to local educational agencies (LEAs), ensuring the success of students and/or schools with a high concentration of economically disadvantages.


- Title II, Part A, the purpose of the program is to increase academic achievement by providing quality staff development, and improving teacher and principal quality.
