

SENIORS who are planning on attending Butte College in August 2026 please make sure you have followed the below steps:

What is the Reg2Go program?

Reg2Go allows high school seniors to participate in orientation, counseling, and registration for Butte College prior to the end of their senior year. By completing the Reg2Go program, the steps below will have the advantage of beginning the process of registering for classes well before all other new and transfer students. It is FREE and makes signing up for Butte College easy.

Step 1: Attend Application Workshop and Apply to Butte College (December 2/3)

The Butte College application workshop will be held at CHS in the library on Tuesday, 12/2 and Wednesday, 12/3. Students will be released out of their current Gov/Econ classes to attend workshop.

****It is important that you attend one of the above two dates.**

Within 7-10 days, students should receive an email from Butte with their Butte College Student ID #, username, and password. Once received, please sign in and create a new password. If you did not receive the Butte ID number, password, and username, please call (530)895-2511 they will resend it.

Please note: Students apply online to Butte College for the semester beyond high school as "Reg-2-Go" students. Applications for Butte College may be found at buttecollege.edu

STEP 2: Complete Required Google Form (completed at application workshop in December 2/3):

After you complete the application and receive the Butte College ID number, please sign up for field trip date in March/April and grab a field trip form. This step is one at the application workshop in December. *If you have missed the workshop please stop in counseling office.

Step 3: Complete FAFSA or CADAA (October-March)

In order to receive the two years offree tuition from Butte College, students must fill out the FAFSA application or CADAA. The priority deadline to complete this is March 2, 2026. You must create an FSA ID for yourself and your guardian to begin the financial aid application. <https://studentaid.gov/>

Step 4: Orientation /Registration (March/April)

Students will get on a bus to go out to Butte College and participate in a full-day field trip, which includes the Butte College orientation, tours of the campus, and register for classes one on one with the Butte College counselors.
