# Special Meeting of July 29, 2025 – 3:30 p.m.

1. CALL TO ORDER – The meeting was called to order by Chair Pipkin at 3:35 p.m. with Commissioners Barsotti, Cerullo, Goodman, Posey, Vice-Chair Boring, and Chair Pipkin present. Commissioner Vaught was absent.

## 2. ARTS & CULTURE GRANT CYCLE 2025-2026 PROJECT SELECTION

#### Recusals:

Commissioner Cerullo recused herself from the review of the Inspire School of the Arts & Sciences and Legacy Theatre applications.

Commissioner Goodman recused herself from the review of the Legacy Theatre application.

Commissioner Boring recused herself from the review of the Museum of Northern California Art (MONCA) application.

It was noted that the total amount requested in the grant applications was \$82,638.50 and the amount available is \$38,435.00.

The Commission reviewed the applications received and discussed the merits of each of the proposed projects.

The Commission considered and disqualified the following three applications:

- Chico Children's Museum for not attaching the budget for their project prior to the application deadline.
- Mi Escuelita Maya Preschool for not attaching the budget for their project.
- Sound Source because the proposed project was for fund raising purposes, which is not a qualifying project under the grant guidelines.

A motion by Chair Pipkin was seconded by Vice-Chair Boring to fund the remaining applications at 52.9% so that all the projects received some funding. The motion passed with the following breakdown:

- Friends of the Chico Community Ballet to receive \$2,646.00 for "A Very Chico Nutcracker 2025" (6-0-1, Vaught absent).
- Inspire School of Arts & Sciences to receive \$2,646.00 for "Big Fish Design Mentorship" (5-0-1-1, Vaught absent, Cerullo disqualified).
