Transfer Requests

You may add students for the upcoming school year in SEIS. You are unable to report any transactions from SEIS to CALPADS until CALPADS completes their academic year rollover, which is expected in late August, early September.

When searching for new students in SEIS search by using combinations of: SSID, names, name misspellings, and date of birth options to locate your student. Also keep an eye out for duplicate SEIS records and when a SEIS record is not found. Duplicate records can be merged, and a new SEIS record can be created if a SpEd student does not yet have a SEIS record.

IEP Caseload Review: Key Reminders and Action items

- Review your caseload to ensure it is current
- Request exits for student that are no longer enrolled, or you are no longer supporting
- Review your student's reporting LEA and school of attendance for accuracy
- Please contact your district level user for any discrepancies
- Review the info eligibility page for all transfers in to review timeline compliance
- Supporting TK students? Consider taking the DRDP course.
- Calendar your IEP meetings in advance
- Don't assume incoming IEPs are accurate
