ELA	Complete the ELA assignment provided by your teacher. Notes from Teacher:	Read a book, magazine, article, or other grade-level-appropriate material for 20 minutes. Write a 3-4 sentence summary of what you read and a reaction to it. Be sure to include the title of the book, magazine, article, or other grade-level-appropriate material.	
Math	Complete the Math assignment provided by your teacher. Notes from Teacher:	Complete one of these math activities: • Read World Equations: Look around your home for items that come in groups (like pairs of socks or sets of utensils). Create 2 word problems using multiplication or division with those items, solve the problem, and then write your work on paper. • Multiplication/Division Flashcards: Create flashcards by writing at least 10 multiplication or division equations on one side of an index card or pieces of paper. Shuffle the flashcards and test yourself by quickly solving each problem, then check your work for accuracy.	
Science	Complete the Science assignment provided by your teacher. Notes from Teacher:	Pick one gadget from home (like a stapler, can opener, cellphone, or remote). Look at your gadget and write 2-3 sentences answering: • What is the gadget and why did you choose it? • What does it do, and how does it work? • Try using it and write one question you have about it. If needed, an adult can help you write sentences.	
P.E.	If you are unable to complete physical activity, keep a food journal for your day. Write what you ate and what food groups they are a part of.	Complete 20 minutes of physical activity (walking, yoga, sports, play, dance, etc.). Record your exercise details in your P.E. log
