CRITERIA

Eligibility for scholarship awards is on the following basis:

1. The recipient must be a graduate of a high school located within the California counties of Yuba & Sutter.
2. The recipient's minimum high school grade point average must be 3.0 based upon a 4.0 grading system, or its equivalent if grading is based upon another system.
3. The recipient must provide proof of enrollment in at least twelve (12) academic units per semester during the year of the scholarship award, an equivalent number of academic units per quarter if on a quarterly based system, or the full time participation in a trade school curriculum.

If you are a student who qualifies in all other respects and enrolled in less than 12 academic units per semester, the committee will accept your application and consider the extenuating circumstances that preclude your "full-time" enrollment.

4. The awards Committee will screen all applications and may hold oral interviews of the candidates.
5. Renewing students must achieve a minimum grade point average of 2.75 during any individual quarter or semester and maintain a 3.0 overall grade point average after the first year at an accredited college or trade school. Each recipient reapplying must have successfully completed 12 units during the immediately preceding semester, or the equivalent number of units per quarter, or the full time equivalent at a trade school, during the scholarship year. Twenty-four semester units (or quarterly or trade school equivalent) must be maintained annually during the four year maximum term of the scholarship.

Upon confirmation of enrollment, the Committee shall have the option to pay the scholarship funds directly to the educational institution with the instruction that the funds are to be used to defray the recipient's educational expenses including, but not limited to tuition, books, extracurricular activities and room and board.

In reviewing a scholarship application, the Committee shall not consider the applicant's race, national origin, age, sex, religion, or physical disability but shall give consideration to the candidate's merit, intelligence, character, industry, academic achievement and leadership qualities. The Committee shall also accept and give consideration to recommendation from high school counselors, teachers and club leaders who know the candidate. The recipient's economic needs may be considered along with academic achievement, but the scholarship awards shall not be restricted due to lack of perceived need or family income.
