2.2 [Enrollment Report](#) – Craig Guensler

- At the time of the agenda, we had 1357 students. This is 19 less than this time last year and 2 more than last month's report.

- We have 76 students currently enrolled in our Preschool Program which is 17 less than last year but the same as last month.
- We have a total of 1433 in all groups. That's 36 less than we had at this time last year and 2 more than last month.
