Listed below are supplies that we suggest students bring to class this coming school year. This suggested list has been compiled based on needs identified to support the delivery of the grade level curriculum.

Please note that the Constitution of the State of California requires that we provide a public education to you free of charge. Your right to a free education is for all school/educational activities, whether curricular or extracurricular, and whether you get a grade for the activity or class. Subject to certain exceptions, your right to a free public education means that we cannot require you or your family to purchase materials, supplies, equipment or uniforms for any school activity, nor can we require you or your family to pay security deposits for access, participation, materials, or equipment.

Therefore, while this list suggests that students bring a number of items, they are considered voluntary. No student will be restricted from participation if they are not sent to school.

4th Grade School Supply List

suggested for individual students to have in their pencil pouch/ box (students will take their pencil pouches/boxes home every day as we switch classes. Please replenish supplies as needed)
