

**NOTICE OF PLANNED CLOSURE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY/ENFORCEMENT OF CAMPING ORDINANCES TO
LEGAL SERVICES OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA (“LSNC”)**

This notice serves as the required notice of the City’s planned closure of public property / enforcement of its Anti-Camping Ordinances and Regulations pursuant to Paragraph 10(c) of *Warren, et al. v. City of Chico, et al.* Settlement Agreement.

Location of Public Property 1: Lindo Channel, further defined as the area on the West side near Montego Way, going East to the Esplanade. Please see the Lindo Channel map below.

The City has determined there are (10) people camping at this location. Of those people, (2) have been assessed during a prior enforcement operation. Those (2) persons should not be included in the count because they have already refused shelter or have been exited from a shelter due to behavioral problems. Further, there are (5) abandoned or unoccupied campsites at this location.

Location of Public Property 2: Bike Path, further defined as the bike path between East Ave. and Burnap Ave. Please see the bike path map below.

The City has determined there are (10) people camping at this location. Of those people, (5) have been assessed during a prior enforcement operation. Those (5) persons should not be included in the count because they have already refused shelter or have been exited from a shelter due to behavioral problems. Further, there are (3) abandoned or unoccupied campsites at this location.

Location of Public Property 3: Chico Municipal Center, further defined as the area from the sidewalk on the southeast side of Fifth Street to the sidewalk on the northeast side of Fourth Street and from the sidewalk on the west side of Main Street to the east side of Flume Street, as indicated on the attached Municipal Center Map.

The City has determined there are (14) people camping at this location. Of those people, (8) have been assessed during a prior enforcement operation. Those (8) persons should not be included in the count because they have already refused shelter or have been exited from a shelter due to behavioral problems. Further, there are (4) abandoned or unoccupied campsites at this location.

The City will provide the “7-DAY NOTICE OF CLOSURE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY/ENFORCEMENT OF CAMPING ORDINANCES” to all Homeless Persons at this location on March 12th 2026. Further, the City requests LSNC meet with the Target Team to verify counts and confirm the location of enforcement prior to that date. If LSNC disagrees with the City’s count and contends there are too many people camping at these locations than there are beds available, the City proposes beginning enforcement operations and will stop enforcing on persons at this location who cannot enter shelter because one of the shelters has become fully occupied.

The City has determined there are (27) available pallet shelters at Genesis.

The City has determined there are (17) available beds at the Torres Community Shelter. (8) of those beds are in the men’s dorm, (5) are in the women’s dorm, and (1) are in the overflow dorm.
