NEVADA CITY – The Nevada County Transportation Commission and Caltrans invites the public to join an open house for the State Route 49 Multimodal Corridor Improvement Project on Thursday, October 2, from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. at the Eric Rood Administrative Center, Nevada County Board of Supervisors' Chamber, 950 Maidu Avenue, in Nevada City.

The purpose of the meeting is for the public to learn more about the project and provide input on the proposed improvements along the corridor. The project runs along State Route 49 from the State Route 20/49/Uren Street intersection to Nevada County Juvenile Hall and proposes to enhance safety by constructing two roundabouts, pedestrian crossings, shared-use paths, sidewalks and installing new lighting and signage.

This project was developed in partnership with Nevada County, Nevada City, Nevada County Transportation Commission (NCTC), and Caltrans. The Project Approval and Environmental Document (PA&ED) phase is anticipated to be complete by the end of this year, with construction scheduled to begin in spring 2028.
