Eligibility:

1. Full- Time student who will pursue an agricultural degree in Plant/Soil Science or Agricultural Business
2. Scholarship performance in academic subjects with an adequate GPA of 3.0 or higher
3. Active and involved in school/ community
4. Work experience will also be considered.
5. Plans to attend any accredited two- or four-year college or university in the United States.
6. No Financial need required.

Selection:

1. Based on eligibility outlined above
2. Reviewed by NorCal CAPCA committee
3. Committee decision final.

- 1. There are two (2) scholarships that will be offered by the Northern California Chapter of the California Association of Pest Control Advisors. *High School Scholarship Recipient = \$1,000
*College Scholarship Recipient = \$1,000
- 2. Applicant must be a full-time high school senior or full-time student at a vocational school, business college, junior college, four-year college or university, or attending graduate school. Part-time students will be considered if they demonstrate compelling circumstances.
- 3. The Applicant must be a U.S. citizen to be eligible to participate and meet the other criteria.
- 4. Each scholarship will be awarded to the student upon submission of an adequate GPA (3.0 or higher) to the CAPCA NorCal board for each semester.
- 5. Each scholarship is good only for the academic year in which it is awarded and will be forfeited if the student does not attend school in the 2026 Fall Semester/Quarter.
- 6. Each applicant must fill out an application, submit a copy of their most recent transcripts, provide a copy of their birth certificate or other form of government issued identification, and submit their paragraph.
- 7. Applicants that do not meet all the scholarship criteria but have compelling special circumstances may still apply.

- 9. The Board of Directors will select the recipients, and the names of the recipients will be announced by June 19, 2026. decisions of the Board of Directors are final.
