

STUDENTS EXPELLED FROM OTHER DISTRICTS

The Yolo County Board of Education and the Yolo County Office of Education may grant admission to students expelled from districts in accordance with law and when consistent with the County Office's goal to provide a safe and secure environment for students and staff.

(cf. 0450 - Comprehensive Safety Plan)

Enrollment During the Term of the Expulsion

The County Office shall not enroll a student expelled by a district for any of the offenses listed in Education Code 48915(a) or (c) (mandatory expulsion offenses) during the term of the student's expulsion, unless the enrollment is at a community school or a community day school. (Education Code 48915.2)

Upon receiving a request for enrollment from a student expelled from a district for acts other than those specified in Education Code 48915(a) or (c), the County Office shall hold a hearing to determine whether the student poses a continuing danger to students or staff. The hearing shall be conducted and notice shall be provided in accordance with procedures governing expulsion of students described in Education Code 48918. (Education Code 48915.1)

(cf. 5144.1 - Suspension and Expulsion/Due Process)

If the student or parent/guardian neglects to inform the County Office that the student was expelled from his/her previous district for an act other than those listed in Education Code 48915(a) or (c), the County Office shall record and discuss this lack of compliance during the hearing. (Education Code 48915.1)

If the County Office finds that a student expelled for acts other than those specified in Education Code 48915(a) or (c) does not pose a continuing danger to students or staff, the student may be admitted or conditionally admitted during the term of expulsion. If the County Office determines that the student does pose a continuing danger to students or staff, the student shall not be admitted. (Education Code 48915.1)

(cf. 5145.6 - Parental Notifications)

Enrollment After the Term of the Expulsion

A student expelled for an act specified in Education Code 48915(a) or (c) may enroll in the County Office after the term of his/her expulsion if the County Office finds, at a hearing, that the student does not pose a continuing danger to students or staff. The hearing shall be conducted and notice shall be provided in accordance with procedures governing expulsion of students described in Education Code 48918. (Education Code 48915.2)

STUDENTS EXPELLED FROM OTHER DISTRICTS (continued)

A student expelled for any act other than those specified in Education Code 48915(a) or (c) may request enrollment after the term of his/her expulsion in accordance with the County Office's procedures for establishing residency or interdistrict transfer.

Voluntary Transfers to Community Day School:

The County Office may enroll students in a community school or community day school at the request of a school district of attendance only if the student's parent, guardian, or responsible adult has requested such enrollment. However, a student shall not be enrolled in a county community school unless the school district determines that the placement will promote the educational interests of the student, and the community school has space available to enroll the student. (Education Code 1981)

Furthermore, a parent, guardian, or responsible adult may rescind the request for placement at any time. In such circumstances, the student shall be immediately reenrolled in the school the student attended prior to the referral, or at another appropriate school with the consent of the parent, guardian, or responsible adult. (Education Code 1981)
