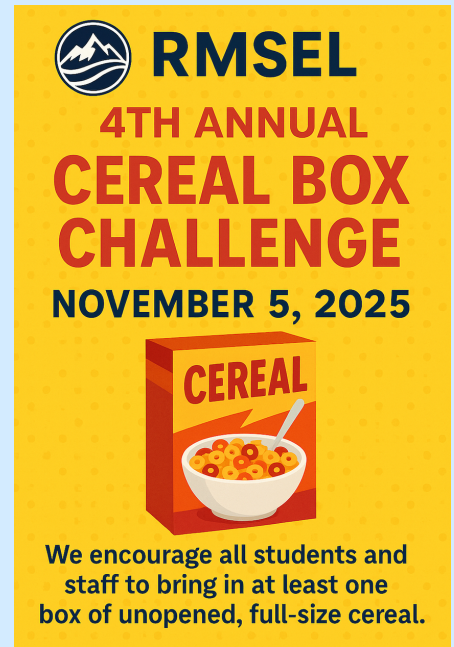
Kinder Toy Donations

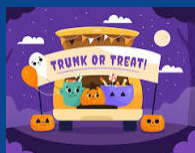


Bagel Sign-Up
