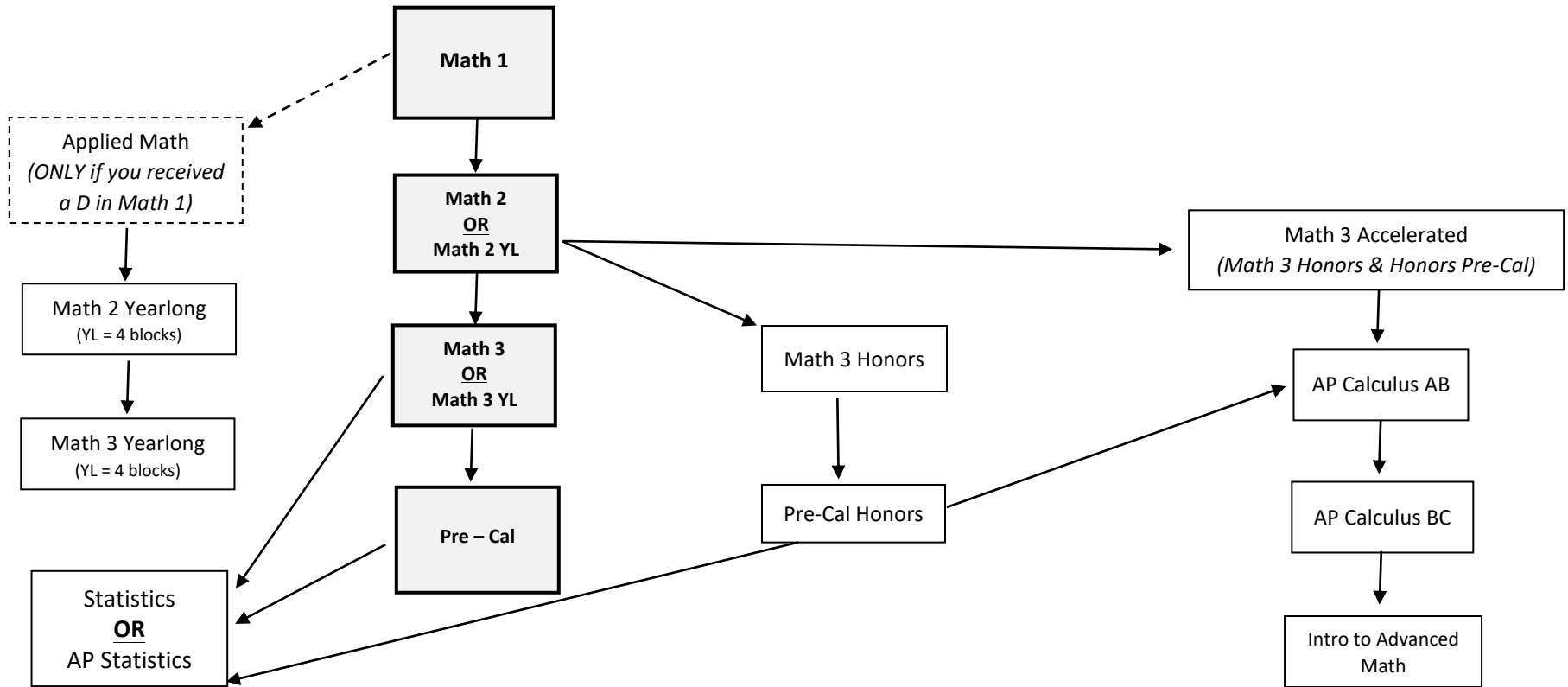


# Franklin High School Math Flow Chart

**TO START: Find your current math course on the flow chart. Follow the arrows to class choices.**

- A. If you received a **C or better** in your current math class, follow the arrow to your next class.
  - a. Yearlong (YL) Math 2 & Math 3 offers more instructional time for students who need additional support.
- B. If you received a **D or lower**, you need to repeat the course you are currently in (9<sup>th</sup> through 11<sup>th</sup>) **unless**:
  - a. If you receive a **D in Math 1**, you can repeat it, or move on to Applied Math (See your Counselor with questions)
  - b. **Seniors** must take a math class. It is recommended to take the highest-level math you can that align with your college/career goals.
    - i. Any senior can take Financial Literacy, but it doesn't prepare students for advanced math classes in college like Stats & Calculus.



**Summer School:** It is best to wait and retake a math class the following school year if you get below a C. If you do attend summer school to retake math, it is recommended to take yearlong math the following year.

**In order to graduate from high school, students MUST:**

- \* Pass Math I
- \* Pass a math course in your senior year
- Pass 3 years of math and 3 years of science **OR** 4 years of math and 2 years of science

**In order to attend a 4-year University directly from high school, students MUST:**

- \* Pass Math I, Math II, and Math III with a C or better
