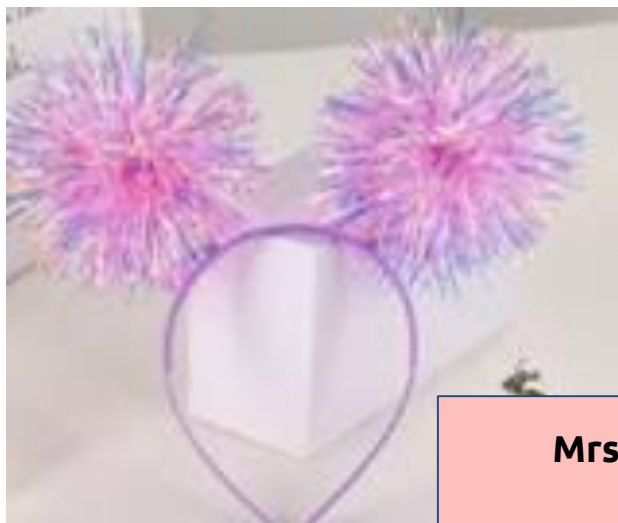
DOs

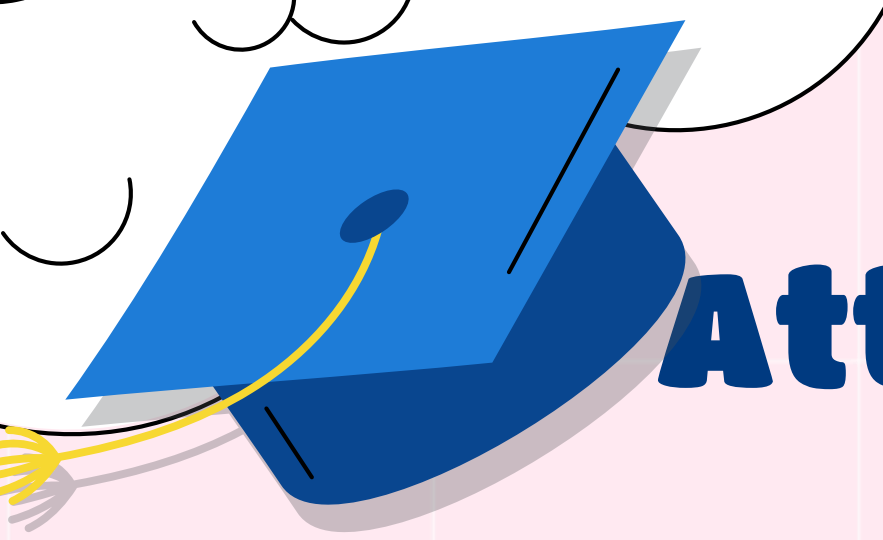
CHROMEBOOK COLLECTION

1st wednesday is learning day, [\(slideshow tutorial\)](#) recommended for those who want to teach, or want to learn

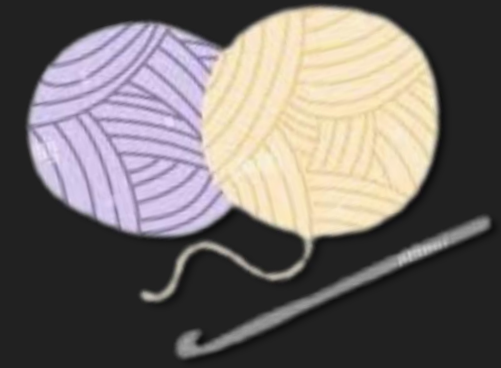

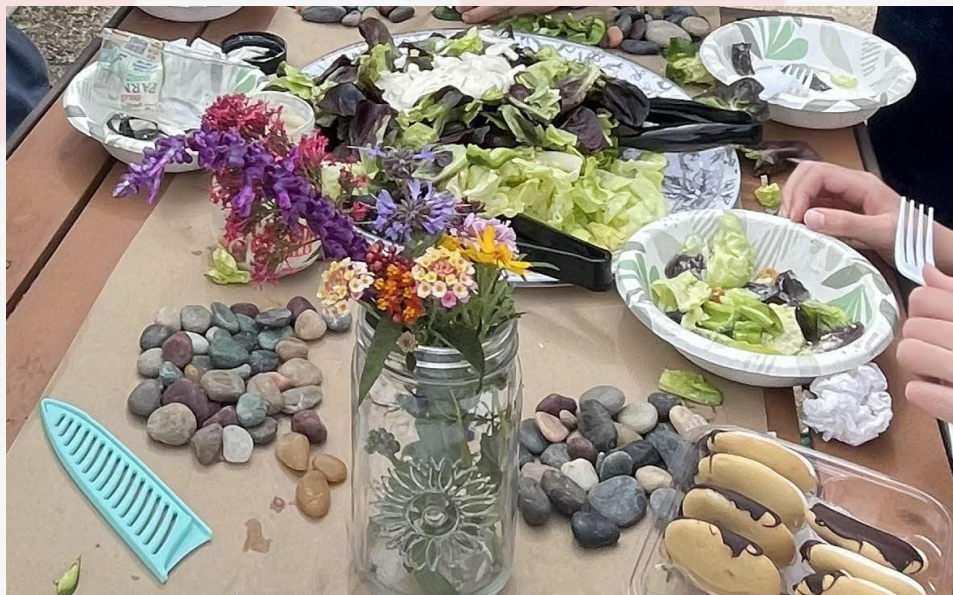
Garden Club

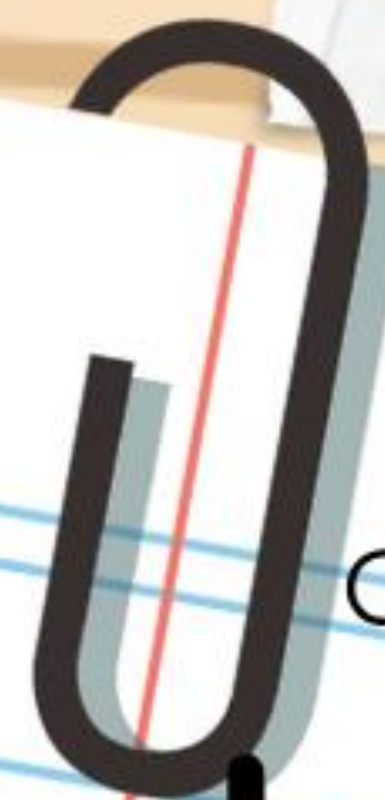
