1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

With the support of Prop 28 funding, we were able to reestablish a music program on our campus. We hired a 0.17 FTE music teacher to teach one period of music to our students, providing them with access to arts education that had previously been unavailable. Prop 28 funding also allowed us to purchase essential materials including mallets, percussion instruments, drumsticks, music sheets, trumpets, and curriculum needed to successfully launch the course. Our music students quickly became active participants in school and community life—performing at sporting events, and showcasing their talents at both a winter and spring concert for the community. In addition, they had the opportunity to compete at a regional music competition, where they proudly earned first place. This program directly supports the goals of Prop 28 by increasing access to arts education and enriching student experiences through music instruction, performance, and competition.
