

Attention, all juniors and seniors: Parking permit procedures for 2026-2027 school year are as follows:

1. Pay off all school fees-i.e. lost textbooks (with Mrs. Maldonado in the library), lost uniforms, parking tickets, etc. (with Mrs. Taylor in the Student Store or online at the webstore). Students can check their Aeries account to see if they have any outstanding school fees. Office hours for June: Monday-Thursday, June 8-30, 8:00 am-3:00pm, Closed Friday's and June 18th; July: Closed; August: Monday-Friday, August 3-7, 7:30 am-3:00 pm.
2. Once student fees are cleared students will visit the school website (www.shastawolves.com) and open the link labeled "Student Parking Information" on the front page of the website.
3. Once the Parking link is open students will need to do the following to be entered into the 2026-2027 parking lottery.
 - a. Students will need to fill out the Google Parking Form/Application and submit it to Mrs. Price.
 - b. Attach the completed Parking Contract in the Google Parking Form/Application.
 - c. Attach their Drivers License, Current DMV (Vehicle) Registration and Proof of Vehicle Insurance in the Google Parking Form/Application.
4. The deadline for submitting parking paperwork for the parking lottery is 3:00 PM; Tuesday, August 4, 2026.
5. Only students who have completed all the parking paperwork and have no fees will be entered into the Parking Lottery.
6. Friday, August 7, 2026-2027 Parking Lottery results will be posted by 10:00 AM outside the SHS Student Store by student ID number and parking lot awarded from the lottery. An email will also be sent confirming which parking lot you received from the lottery.
7. August 7th, 10th, and 11th, parking permits may be paid for and picked up in the Student Store between the hours of 1:00-3:00 PM. Students may also pay online via the online Student Store but will still need to physically pick up their permit prior to school starting, Wednesday, August 12, at the times listed above. Purchasing online is highly encouraged to avoid long lines on August 7th, 10th, and 11th.
8. Any permits not pick up on August 7th, 10th, or 11th, will be forfeited and placed in a secondary parking lottery in September.
9. Shasta High School will ticket the first day/week of school and even if you have purchased a permit but have not picked it up you will be responsible for any tickets you may receive.
