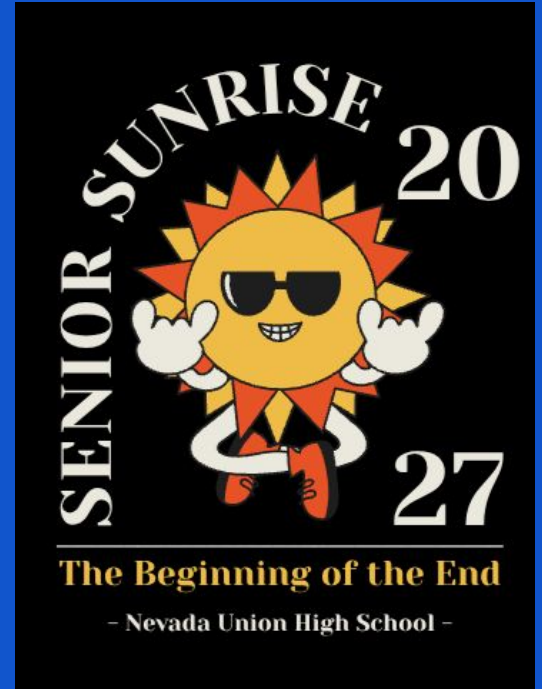

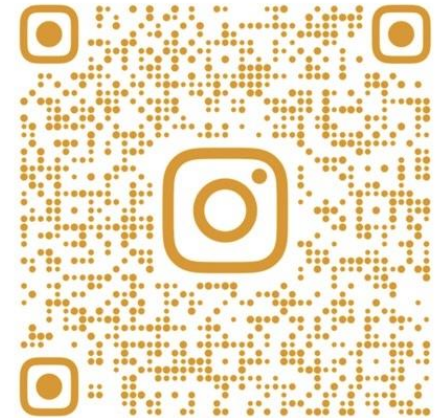

ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS:

- Students who are 18 years old may legally excuse themselves from school.
- **ALL** Proper check-out procedures must be followed, including
 - **Students must check out with the Attendance Office, or they will be considered truant.** After checking out, a student must leave campus immediately.
- **18-year-old students are still subject to all consequences related to excessive tardies and/or absences, including the School Attendance Management process and the No-Go list.**



GRADUATION PARTICIPATION

Participation in senior activities and graduation events is a privilege. Students may be excluded from graduation-related activities, including but not limited to Senior Breakfast, Honors Night, Graduation Rehearsal, and the Graduation Ceremony, if they:

- Are on the school's No-Go List;
- Have a cumulative attendance rate below 85% for the total school year;
- Seniors with excessive behavior problems or major infractions may not participate in the graduation ceremony at the discretion of school administration.

NO GO List

What is the No-Go List?

The No-Go List is a list of students who have temporarily lost the privilege to attend school events. Students may be placed on the list if they have an unserved consequence (like detention), owe a fine, or break a school rule.

What happens if I'm on the No-Go List?

You won't be allowed to go to school-wide events like:

- Dances
- Rallies
- Athletic games (as a spectator)
- Field trips
- Other extra-curricular activities
- **INCLUDES ALL SENIOR ACTIVITIES!**

How do I get off the list?

- Fix the issue that put you on it—serve your consequence, clear your fine, or talk to an admin if you're not sure. Once it's taken care of, your privileges will be restored.

Uniform/Dress

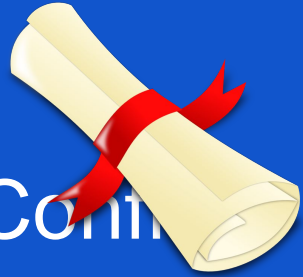
- **Semi-Formal:**
