The Toolbox Program

During the month of February, our Cubs will be learning the next 2 tools of the Toolbox program:



Garbage Can Tool

Tagline: I let the little things go.

Icon: A garbage can

Hand gesture: Place one hand on your hip creating an open semicircle. With the other hand, make a “throwing-away” gesture into the open space under the arm. Or, make a “thumbs-up” sign with one hand, then flip thumbs down (as if closing the lid on the garbage can).



Taking Time Tool

Tagline: I take time-in and time-away.

Icon: A watch

Hand gesture: Gently tap your wrist (an imaginary watch) with your index finger. Our students learn best via modeling, so be sure to practice and use these tools with your Cub(s)!
