Mrs. Reichardt and Mrs, Naghavi's Cubs Counseling Corner, March 2026

- Encourage a "power of yet" mindset (e.g., "I can't do it yet").
- Model Resilience: Let kids see you struggle with tasks and hear how you overcome frustration to keep going.
- Set Small Goals: Break down big, overwhelming tasks into smaller, achievable steps to build confidence.
- Identify Feelings: Help children identify when they feel frustrated, and encourage them to take a break before returning to the task.
- Use Literature: Read books that highlight perseverance, such as *The Crocodile Who Didn't Like Water* or *Emmanuel's Dream*

Cubs Club Trait of the Month

Cubs are being recognized for showing **Perseverance!** At home, help teach your Cub(s) perseverance with the following tips:

- Praise the Process: Focus compliments on the effort, strategies, and persistence a child uses, rather than simply calling them "smart" or "talented".
- Normalize Mistakes: Explain that mistakes are a natural, necessary part of learning.

Returning From Spring Break

School breaks can sometimes bring a need to reorient your student to the school routine. Returning to school from break may be anxiety producing for some students. Remember, the first few days of drop off may be challenging as everyone adjusts to being back at school.

Hopefully the following tips will help make school drop off a success:

- Get into a routine. Involve your student in picking out their clothing, packing their snacks, etc.
- Continue to be positive!
- **Make a QUICK exit!** Have a "goodbye" routine and stick to it. Staff are available to help if needed.
- Monitor your own feelings; our children take emotional cues from us. If we appear anxious, your student may become anxious too.
- It is best to not take your student home; this sends the message that if they cry then they get to leave.


