Program Details

- Year-long student teaching placement with a mentor teacher
- Resident stipend provided (\$35,000 stipend, subject to applicable taxes and withholdings)
- Opportunity to work as a substitute teacher a few days a week, on average, OR as a paraprofessional
- Designed around PK-12 schools
- Synchronous coursework through Teacher's College of San Joaquin (TCSJ) Monday and Wednesdays from 4:30 PM - 9:00 PM
- Available Credentials:** Multiple Subject, Single Subject*, Mild to Moderate Support Needs, Extensive Support Needs

**Single Subject content areas are dependent upon available mentor teachers*

Eligibility Requirements

- Bachelor's Degree or higher from a regionally accredited institution
- United States Constitution Requirement (fulfilled in most bachelor's programs)
- Certificate of Clearance or valid document issued by the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing ([CL-900](#))
- [Subject Matter Competency](#) (if required by your credential pathway)

Program Commitments

- Agree to a one-year residency placement with an experienced mentor teacher
- Commit to teaching at an SCTRP-designated high-needs site for a minimum of four years following the residency year
- Successfully complete all required coursework and assessments to earn a preliminary credential

Admission Deadlines and Important Dates

- February 2nd - February 20, 2026:** SCTRP Application period
- March 16 - March 19, 2026:** Interviews
- March 15 - April 15, 2026:** TCSJ Application period
- June 16, 2025:** Admission for both TCSJ and SCTRP
- July 7, 2025:** Coursework Enrollment
- July 14, 2025:** TCSJ Synchronous Coursework begins
- August 4, 2025:** Clinical Practice Start Date
