Board Approved Local Control and Accountability Plan Goals

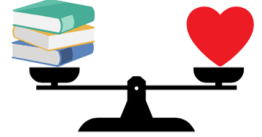


Goal 1:

Each student's individual social-emotional and academic needs will be met through quality first instruction, enrichment, and intervention in a safe, supportive, and inclusive environment.



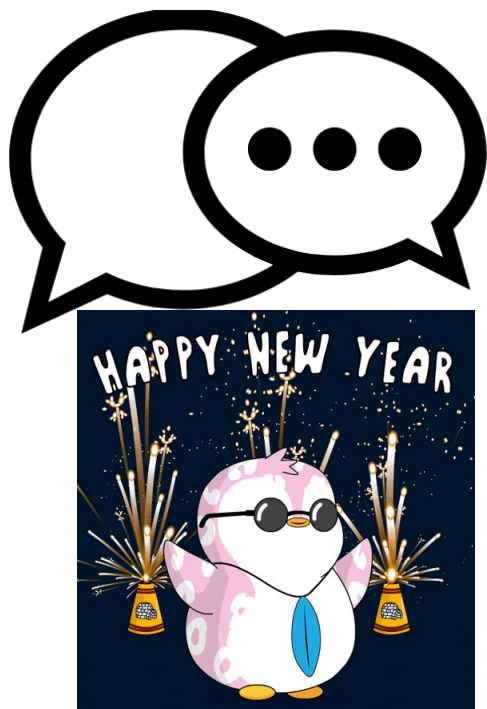
Goal 3:

Reading Difficulties Screener

- New state law requires all K-2 students to be screened for reading difficulties
- WJUSD piloted and adopted Multitudes in spring 2025
- Students will be screened in February 2026
 - This is a 1:1 assessment which will give teachers valuable information about student progress
 - Parents can opt out by sending a written notification to the principal
 - Results will be shared at the parent/teacher conferences in March



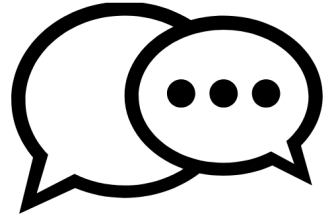

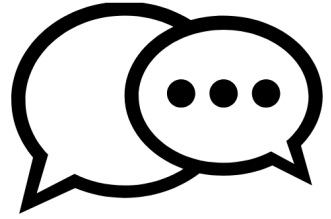
