This time was 3rd best in the entire nation for sophomore runners!! Additionally, Will also broke two school records and personal bests in both the 500 Free and 100 Breaststroke with times of 4:45.04 and 1:02.66 respectively. Amazing accomplishments by both of our athletes!!

- **Third Quarter Grading Window:** Grades have been posted to Aeries.
 - All student-athletes must earn a minimum GPA of 2.0 for the grading period and
 - Student-athletes must have no more than 2 NM on their grade report.
 - Student-athletes will become ineligible for participation in athletic contests beginning on Friday, April 10, 2026 if they have 3+ NC or a GPA below 2.0.
- **Athlete Game Day Attendance:** To stay eligible for game days, athletes must maintain **100% classroom attendance**.
 - [Requirement:](#) Students must be in class all day to play.
 - [Clearing Absences:](#) If an athlete must be absent for any part of the day, you must contact the Athletic Department directly.
