

Our classrooms read and discussed *The Dot* and completed simple art projects with only two directions: start with a dot and sign your name! We encouraged our students to "make their mark!"



WHAT ARE SKILLS FOR LEARNING?

Second Step is CUSD's social-emotional learning curriculum. It builds school success, connection, and a safe, respectful climate by teaching empathy, emotion management, problem solving, and key learning skills in four core areas, specifically:

- <u>Listening</u> Children learn how to give their full attention, follow directions, and show others they are engaged. Active listening helps them pick up on important details and strengthens peer relationships.
- 2. <u>Focusing Attention</u> With so many distractions around, it's important for students to practice concentrating on what's most important. This skill supports reading, problem-solving, and even managing emotions.
- 3. <u>Using Self-Talk</u> Positive self-talk helps students remind themselves of directions, stay calm, and encourage perseverance. Phrases like "I can do this" or "Slow down and check my work" build resilience.
- 4. <u>Being Assertive</u> Students learn to ask for help, share ideas respectfully, and stand up for themselves in safe and respectful ways. Assertiveness helps children express themselves with confidence while respecting others.

Research shows that when children practice these abilities regularly, they are better able to manage their behavior, work cooperatively, and stay engaged in class.
