Why boundary changes are being considered

Residential growth is increasing elementary enrollment in south Elk Grove.

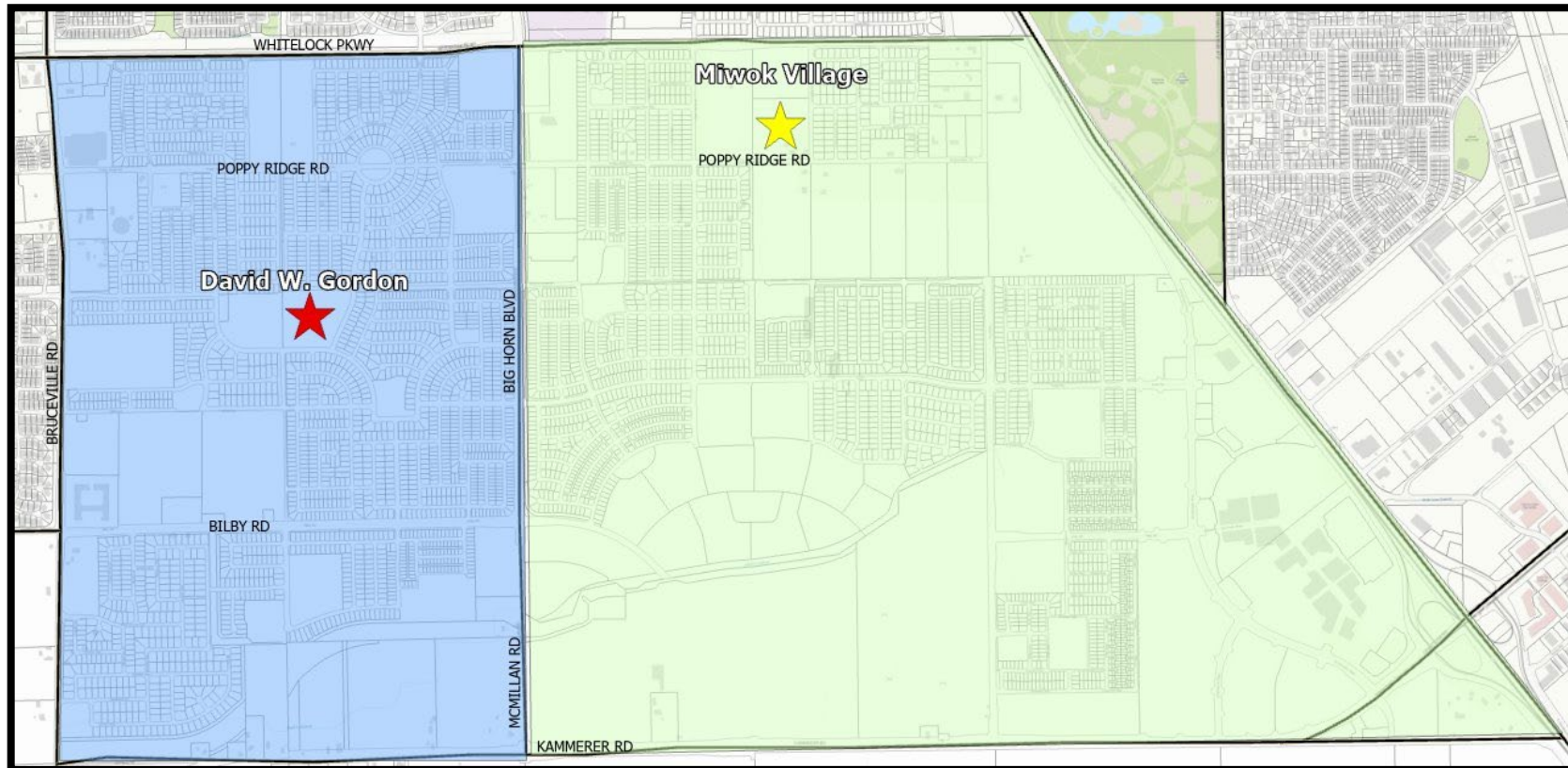

Needed to serve existing and

The goal is to balance enrollment, avoid overcrowding, and provide families with stable attendance areas.

Proposed Boundary

The proposed attendance boundary for David W. Gordon Elementary School will modify the current attendance area for Miwok Village Elementary School. Under the proposal, Big Horn Boulevard will serve as the primary dividing line between the two attendance areas.



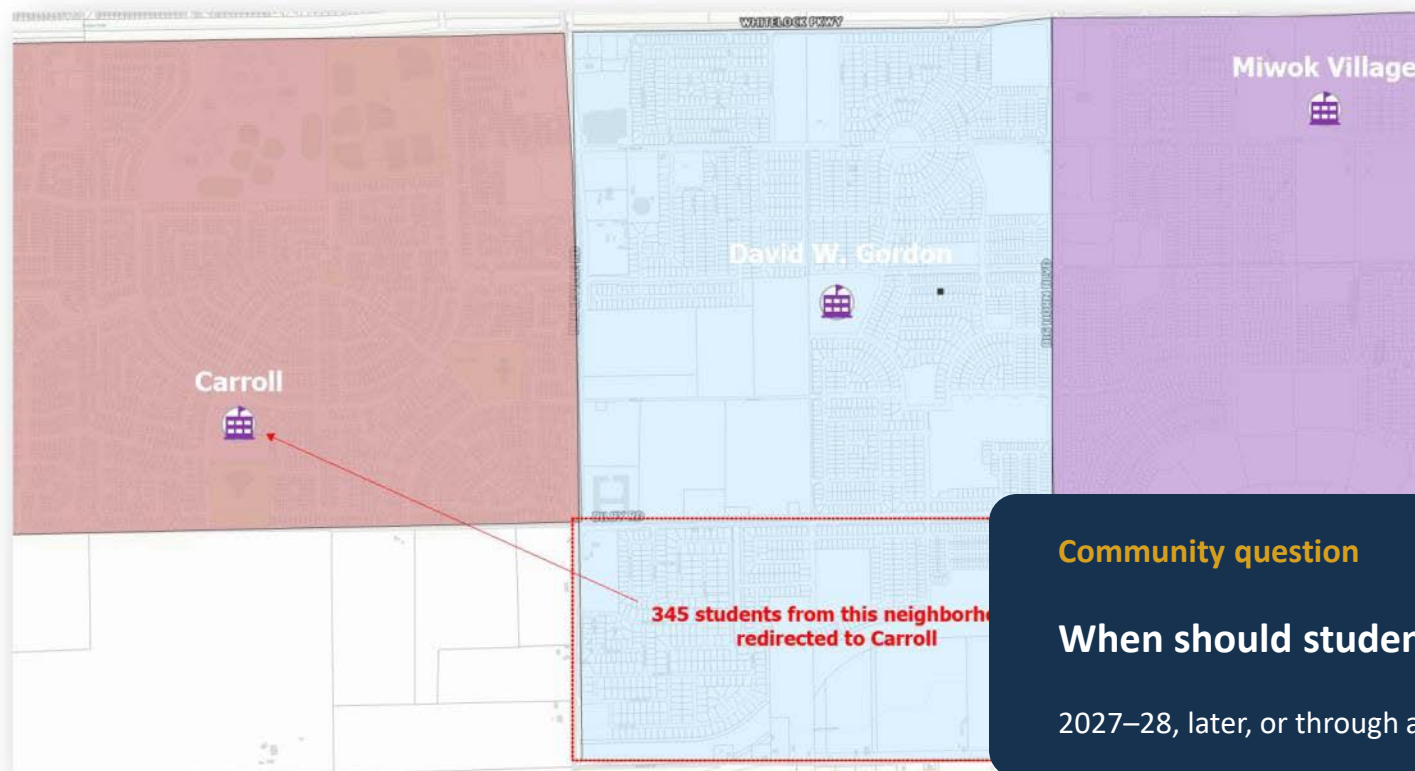
Enrollment outlook and Carroll capacity

3-year outlook	David W. Gordon: 1,425	Miwok Village: 952	About 2,400 combined
5–10-year outlook	David W. Gordon: 1,564	Miwok Village: 1,195	About 2,700 combined
10+ year outlook	David W. Gordon: 1,583	Miwok Village: 1,293	About 2,876 combined

Carroll currently serves 875 students (72% of capacity) and is projected at 70% of capacity in five years. This available space supports the proposed boundary adjustment.

Proposed Subdivision Reassignment

The neighborhood south of Bilby Road and west of McMillan Road to transition from David W. Gordon Elementary to Carroll Elementary



Community question

When should students begin at Carroll?

2027–28, later, or through a phased transition?

What staff is proposing

David W. Gordon boundary

Establish a new attendance area by dividing the current Miwok Village boundary, with Big Horn Boulevard as the primary line.

Proposed start: 2027–28

Carroll boundary adjustment

Move the developing neighborhood south of Bilby Road and west of McMillan Road from David W. Gordon to Carroll.

Timing: community feedback will help shape the transition

Tonight's proposal is for community feedback. The Board has not formally adopted the boundaries or transition timing.
