



I hope you and your family are well. We have been enjoying this lovely weather - both on the playground and throughout our courtyards with students working on their studies in the fresh air.

Attendance Update: Attendance for the week of 03/08 reached 96.01%, placing us on the top 10 list for highest attendance.

CAASPP Testing: Each spring our 3rd, 4th and 5th graders take the state test in English Language Arts and Math (5th grade also takes the Science test). The testing window runs from the week of 04/13/2026 to the week of 05/11/2026. Teachers will be sharing specific testing dates for their classes. Please be sure your child is here each day on time in order to set them up for success.

School Library Month

Arab American Heritage Month

As stated in the Multicultural Education Policy of the California State Board of Education, each student needs an opportunity to understand the common humanity underlying all people.

National Day of Silence: April 17, 2026

San Ramon Valley Unified School District recognizes April 17, 2026 as National Day of Silence. During this student-led national event, some students may choose to take a vow of silence to bring attention to the name calling, bullying and harassment that many LGBTQ+ youth face. SRVUSD promotes respect, tolerance and acceptance on all our campuses and believes that all students and staff have a right to a safe and healthy school environment. National Day of Silence will not alter instruction on April 17, but students may voluntarily participate and teachers may discuss and are asked to be thoughtful and sensitive as they create lesson plans. Teachers will be teaching on this day. The progress pride flag will be flown at the District Office and at all District sites.

Public School Volunteer Appreciation Week: April 20-24

San Ramon Valley Unified School District recognizes the week of April 20-24, 2026 as Public School Volunteer Appreciation Week. The many devoted and dedicated volunteers in our community provide essential support to our students through generous donations of time, talent, and resources. Volunteers enrich learning experiences beyond what is often available for students and selflessly serve on our boards and committees. They play a key role as our partners in education and in fostering a sense of community and pride within our schools and district.

Student Placement Information Form:

As we look toward next year it is time for us to start working on class placements. We work hard to build classes that are balanced from every angle.

This form is not required, however if you believe your child has specific needs and/or excels in a particular type of classroom environment that the staff should consider when placing him/her, you are welcome to complete and return the attached form. Please do not request specific teachers. Letters that state a specific teacher's name or that try to describe a specific teacher will not be considered. **Due by April 1st.**

Parents you are welcome to complete the attached form if you believe your child has specific needs. This form is due to the school office no later than April 01, 2026. After spring break, teachers will meet with Principal Kawahara to begin building balanced classes for the 26/27 school year.

Parents and students will be notified of teacher and classroom placement on

August 12th, 2026. Careful consideration is given to the class placement of each student.

Children who turn 4 (TK) or 5 (Kinder) by September 1, 2026 are eligible to attend.

account. There is a \$2.00 fee for this process. Be sure to upload your Driver's License information as well.




Advocacy Day


Can my child purchase a second meal?

Yes, but they need to have funds on their prepayment account, which can be done on the Titan [Family Portal](#). Cash will not be accepted in the breakfast or lunch line. Cash or checks can be given to the Child Nutrition Manager outside of the breakfast or lunch meal service time. A second breakfast is \$4.00 and a second lunch is \$5.75 at Elementary Schools and \$6.00 at Middle and High Schools. School staff can purchase a breakfast for \$4.50 and lunch for \$6.00.
