- *NFPA works with school districts*
- *Fire extinguishers should be inspected more often*
- *Practice implementation with fire department and police department*
- *Prior Superintendent walked entire school to Community Center as evacuation drill to show that all students can fit into that space (this happened during Red Ribbon Week in the past)*
- *Where is money going to come from to implement and support this plan*
