2025-2026 SJS Dress Down Day Policy

In general, PE uniform bottoms, appropriate for the season, are to be worn with the designated Dress Down Day shirt.

All clothing worn on a Dress Down Day is to be modest and respectful of the Catholic school environment. When in doubt, please choose the more conservative clothing option.

During the school day, hoodies may not be worn inside the school building. Students may use hoodies as outerwear.

If a student chooses not to wear the designated dress down attire, the student is to wear his or her regular school uniform.

Class Holiday Party Day (Halloween and Valentine's Day) -

Kindergarten - 8th grade: Students may wear a festive, holiday shirt with PE uniform bottoms.

PreK and JrK: Teachers will provide instructions for students' Halloween party attire.

Christmas Party -

Students may *dress up* for a fun, festive mass and holiday party. Clothes are to be appropriate for church. PE uniform bottoms are NOT required for this day. Sweatpants, sweatshirts, shorts, pajamas, and jeans are not appropriate for this day. Leggings and tights are acceptable with tops or dresses of an appropriate length in the front and back.

Class Shirt Days -

Students may wear their Class shirt with PE uniform bottoms.

Community/Local Support Days (such as Cardinals opening day) or other reward days -

Students may wear a shirt that matches the designated theme with PE uniform bottoms.

Spring Picture Day -

Students may *dress up* in an outfit of their choice. Clothes should follow our uniform guidelines. PE uniform bottoms are NOT required for this day. Sweatpants, sweatshirts, shorts, pajamas, and jeans are not appropriate for this day. Leggings and tights are acceptable with tops or dresses of an appropriate length in the front and back.
