1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded.

In the 2025-26 school year, Butte County Office of Education spent \$36,397.75 of its \$63,710.95 remaining 23/24 annual allocation from Proposition 28. BCCS and TMS spent a portion of their funds on 2 teaching artist residencies. While, BCCS spent their other funds on various art projects, including making traditional Native American lanyards and necklaces, electronic light up boxes, and a paper crane project that is displayed in their main room. TMS spent their other funds on storage specifically for poster-sized paper, as well as supplies in coordination with the visiting Freedom Writers author. Our Special Ed students at Mesa Vista used the dollars for music enrichment activities, field trips to local musical and theater productions, as well as supplies for lessons in culinary arts. Early Education spent their funds on professional development and supplies in preparation for their upcoming plans with art and music instruction. Lastly, BASES spent their funds on a “direct to garment” printer to enable the students to design and make their own t-shirts when meeting a school goal. 100% of the \$67,870 24/25 allocation and \$55,245 25/26 allocation, will be rolled over into the 2026-27 school year. Given that BCOE’s enrollment is under 500 students, the requirement to spend 80% of the funds on certificated staff does not apply.
