FFA Future Farmers of America Scholarship (For FFA and non-FFA members) Multiple scholarships	High school senior or college student pursuing a degree or certification in specific areas of agriculture. Some scholarships available for non-FFA members--agricultural majors in human nutrition, communications, sales, marketing, public relations, journalism, statistics, mathematics, engineering, bioinformatics, computer science, welding or diesel mechanics	1/9/25
