1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

During the 2024–25 school year, Orland Unified School District utilized Proposition 28 funds to enhance arts and music education across multiple sites. The district hired a music teacher for Mill Street School and Fairview School, enabling the launch of dedicated music programs. These funds also supported essential programmatic needs to ensure students received a well-rounded, high-quality music education. Additionally, CK Price Middle School and Orland High School used their Proposition 28 allocations to employ full-time graphic arts and art teachers, significantly expanding the range of visual arts opportunities available to students. The district further allocated funds toward purchasing materials and supporting arts experiences.
