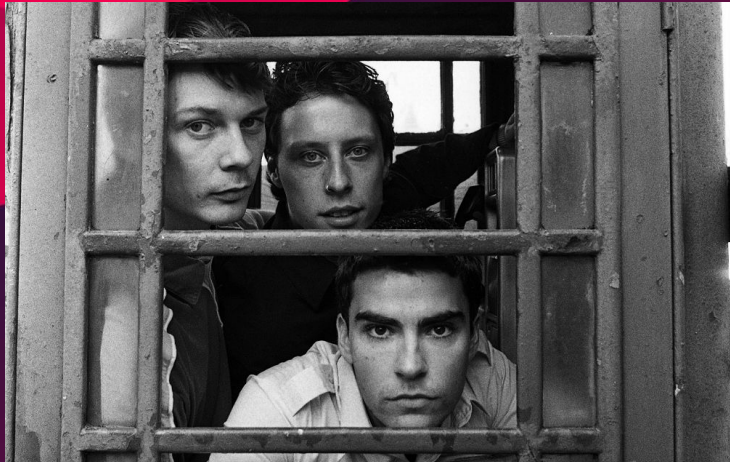
# Current Bulletin Theme Solving Standings: Top Ten
