**This document is intended to bring clarity to the academic eligibility calendar for UIL participants. Specifically, be aware of the following issues:**

- Grace period for eligibility is seven (7) calendar days after the evaluation, with the exception of holidays.
- Academic Eligibility is determined from the nine-week grades, no semester grades.
- After the 1<sup>st</sup> six weeks academic eligibility check, students may only lose academic eligibility at the end of nine weeks grading period (not at three weeks progress report).
- Students may regain eligibility at both the three weeks progress report and at the nine weeks grade report.
- All students are academically eligible during holidays of a full calendar week or more.

\*All students become eligible at the end of the school day before a weeklong (or more) school holiday.

\*\*Evaluation period includes 2 shortened weeks.
