The Toolbox Program

This month our students will be creating a Caring Circle practice in their classrooms. This practice comes directly after students are taught about the Empathy Tool. A Caring Circle acts as a visual reminder of a circle of empathy as it holds those who are of concern to your students and who are currently in their hearts and minds. It is a place to write the names of people or animals that your students are thinking about because they are sick, far away, or having difficult times.

Cubs Club Trait of the Month

For the month of November, students will be honored for showing their *Honesty*! Ways to help encourage your Cubs to be honest is:

- 1. Model the behavior
- Create an environment where your student(s) feel comfortable telling the truth
- 3. Praise honesty (especially in difficult situations)
- 4. Have open conversations in which you discuss the importance of honesty and potential consequences for being dishonest
