 - All students must earn a **GPA of 2.0 for the grading period.**
 - Students must have **no more than 2 NM on their grade report.**
 - Students will be granted two weeks from the end of the grading period to pass Essentials or make up Tests to raise their grade and meet eligibility requirements. Late homework or classwork will NOT be accepted for eligibility purposes.
 - **Students will become ineligible for participation on their team or in athletic contests beginning on Friday, January 23, 2026, if they have 3+ NC or a GPA below 2.0 for the grading period.**
