September is Attendance Awareness Month:

ABSENTEEISM AND ACHIEVEMENT

Did you know?

Poor attendance can influence whether children read proficiently by the end of third grade.

By 6th grade, chronic absence becomes a leading indicator that a student will drop out of high school.

By 9th grade, attendance is a better predictor of graduation rates than 8th grade test scores. This article by the Gates Foundation details why the 9th grade year is so important.

When students are absent, they miss instruction, skill practice, and hands-on learning activities in the classroom that make it harder to catch up. If they are absent for group or partner work, this can also affect the other students they are grouped with.

Parents and caregivers are essential partners in promoting good attendance! Here are some strategies that can help:

Create a consistent schedule and distraction-free workspace; help older students use planners or digital tools to stay organized.

Stay engaged by checking progress, attending events, communicating with teachers, and encouraging your child to seek help.

Encourage participation in clubs and activities; model good listening and compassion to support healthy friendships.

If your child feels anxious about school or a subject, reach out to teachers or counselors to collaborate on support.


Volunteer Clearance - Reminder - NEW REQUIREMENTS





Can my child purchase a second meal?

Yes, but they need to have funds on their prepayment account, which can be done on the Titan Family Portal. Cash will not be accepted in the breakfast or lunch line. Cash or checks can be given to the Child Nutrition Manager outside of the breakfast or lunch meal service time. A second breakfast is \$4.00 and a second lunch is \$5.75 at Elementary Schools and \$6.00 at Middle and High Schools. School staff can purchase a breakfast for \$4.50 and lunch for \$6.00.
