3. Proof of Residence: A copy of a recent utility bill or valid State ID showing your name and the property address.
4. Proof of Income (for SSDI only): Your annual earned income must fall below 250% of the [2012 Federal Poverty Guideline](#). \$27,925 for a one person household, \$37,825 for a two person household, \$47,725 for a three person household, \$57,625 for a four person household...

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APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- Exemption reason #1 **Property owners** who are over 65 years of age or older by July 1, 2026.
 - This parcel tax exemption is for your **principal place of residency only** and applies to one parcel, or one unit of a multiple family structure only.
 - **You only need to apply one time** for the 65 years of age or older exemption. If your application is approved, you will be eligible to receive the exemption for the entire term of the parcel tax, so long as you continue to own and occupy your home.
- Exemption Reasons #2 and #3
 - Owned and occupied as a principal residence by a person receiving Supplemental Security Income for a disability.
 - Owned and occupied as a principal residence by a person receiving Social Security Disability Insurance benefits, whose yearly income does not exceed 250 percent of the 2012 federal poverty guidelines issued by the United States Department of Health and Human Services
- To find your parcel number, look for the ten-digit number (XXX-XXX-XXX-X) on your property tax bill, or call the County Assessor (925) 313-7400.

- **Return on or before July 24, 2026.**
- Prior year refunds will not be granted.
- Any parcel tax that was previously levied on your tax bill is not refundable.
- **This parcel tax exemption is separate from Measure M and Measure K parcel taxes, which have a separate application form that can be obtained from our office or on our district website**
