

# Williams Complaint Annual Notice 2025-2026

Notice to Parents, Guardians, Pupils, and Teachers

Pursuant to California Education Code Section 35186, you are hereby notified that:

#### 1. Sufficient Textbooks and Instructional Materials

Each pupil, including English learners, must have a textbook or instructional materials, or both, to use in class and to take home.

## 2. Clean, Safe, and Maintained Facilities

School facilities must be clean, safe, and maintained in good repair.

# 3. No Teacher Vacancies or Misassignments

Every class should have a teacher assigned to it, not a series of substitutes or other temporary teachers. The teacher must hold the proper credential to teach the class, including certification required for English learners, if present.

- Teacher Vacancy: A position to which a single designated certificated employee has not been assigned at the beginning of the year for the entire year, or for a one-semester course, a position to which a single designated certificated employee has not been assigned at the beginning of the semester for the entire semester.
- Misassignment: Placement of a certificated employee in a teaching or services position for which the employee does not hold a legally recognized certificate or credential, or is not otherwise authorized by statute to hold.

### 4. Filing a Complaint:

If you believe any of the above standards are not being met, a complaint may be filed:

Complaints will be handled promptly and in accordance with California law.
